On September 8-17th 2017 the city of Sevastopol (the Crimea, the RF) hosted the twenty fourth international conference “Mechanical Engineering and Technosphere of the XXI Century”. Prof. A. Mikhailov, the Head of the Department of Mechanical Engineering Technology” of Donetsk National Technical University is the unchallenged organizer of the famous international forum.

DonNTU holds the annual international scientific and technical conference “Mechanical Engineering and Technosphere of the XXI Century” in September, on the eve of Mechanical Engineer’s Day. The meeting of the International Union of Mechanical Engineers also takes place in the frameworks of the conference.

According to the rules, the international scientific and technical forum was opened by its plenary meeting. Prof Mikhailov, Associate Prof. V. Kovalenko, and Senior Lecturer N. Golubov made their presentations there.

The forums like this, creative and fruitful, help consolidate researchers from different countries, exchange research information, and give a creative impulse for further development of mechanical engineering and technosphere.

The official newsletter of the French Republic published the announcement on registration of the Representation Centre of the Donetsk People’s Republic in France on June 17th 2017. The joint work with the Novorossia.today team and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the DPR work had preceded the event. The preliminary work lasted for several months.

Mr. Fayard visited Donetsk both before and during the conflict.

On June the 25th 2017 a French delegation arrived to Donetsk to discuss the details of the

Representation operation. It was received by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the DPR Ms. N. Nikanorova who made her welcoming speech.

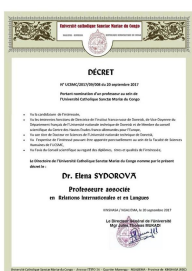
Two months later, on September the 25th 2017, the Representation of the Donetsk People's Republic in Marseilles was inaugurated. Its honorary consul Mr. Fayard greeted the guests: elected representatives of the people, mass media workers, representatives of associations and the government boards.

Ms. Nikanorova had sent her video address to the team of the Representation.

Mr. Fayard said that the information about Donbass was either hidden or misrepresented in France. He reminded that the delegation had seen the suffering of the civilian population who had been attacked by the Ukrainian army since 2014. Thus the main mission of the Representation is to inform the French on the real situation in Donetsk. To do it different exhibitions and shows are planned to take place.

The honorary consul finalized that the Representation was an apolitical and voluntary organization and everyone despite his political orientation would be welcomed there. .

St. Petersburg hosted the Industrial IT Forum 2017 on September 8th. More than 20 people – IT directors, leaders and representatives of industrial companies of Russia and key universities – took part in it. The academics of DonNTU Assistant Professor E. Dubinka and Senior Lecturer M. Marenich represented the DPR there.

There were five breakup groups at the Forum. One of them – “Advanced Industrial Technologies and Trends of Development of Industrial Productions” - discussed the issues of development of computer and information technologies, tendencies of



development of industrial productions. The issues on reduction of time and expenses to make product design, to optimize production process and raise efficiency of product operation were discussed at the breakup group “Control of the Product Life-Cycle and Computer Simulation”. Besides, the new possibilities to develop automation trends which the current IT industry proposes and prospects and problems of development of the

trend on the example of particular companies were also discussed.

Participation in the Forum was useful as to exchange of experience among representatives of key industrial companies and academics, and it will help improve the quality of higher education. The representatives of DonNTU have a new view of the problems our industry faces, got knowledge on modern tendencies of information technologies in the field of industrial automation.

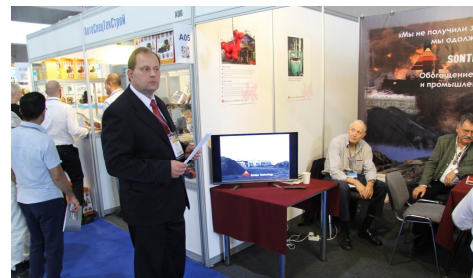

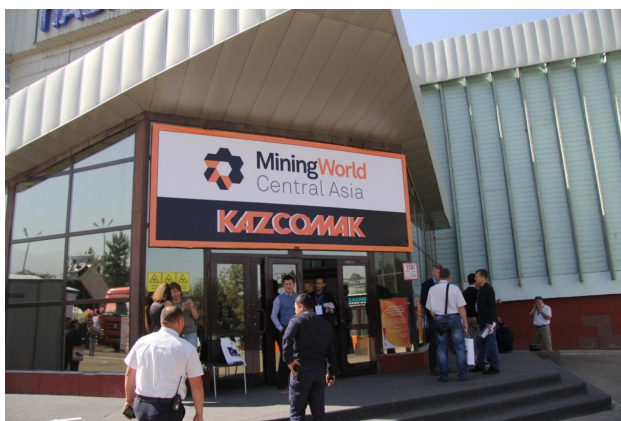

Students of 18 countries of the world arrived to Moscow late September. They participated in the international festival of students and youth's sport "Moscow Games -2017". The festival started in 2014. There were sportsmen from Russia, China, Germany, Bulgaria, Afghanistan, Switzerland, Lebanon, Slovakia, Spain, Algeria, Israel, Austria, Kyrgyzstan, Croatia, Belarus and Latvia.
