



III International Forum of Students, Postgraduates and Young Miners «Problems of Mining»

On April 6-7, Donetsk National Technical University held the III International Forum of Students, Postgraduates and Young Miners «Mining Problems». **Co-organizers: Donbas State Technical University (Alchevsk), Don State Technical University (Rostov-on-Don), St. Petersburg Mining University, Tula State University, Kuzbass State Technical University named after T.F. Gorbachev (Kemerovo).** The event was held in the off-line and online format using the platform «Yandex-Telebridge». Fifty-three reports from participants from 14 organizations were adopted in six thematic areas.

The forum was opened by the Vice-Rector of DONNTU Prof. S.V. Borshchevsky. He spoke about the integration of DONNTU into the educational and scientific space of Russia and the new opportunities it offers for students, postgraduate students and young scientists, as well as

the prospects of Donbas as an industrial region. The Dean of the Faculty of Mining of DONNTU A.N. Korchevsky addressed to the participants with a welcome speech. He reported on the prospects of expanding the cooperation of the faculty with foreign universities and organizations. Colleagues and long-time friends of Donetsk polytechnics-miners also spoke: the Head of the Department of Building Geotechnologies if DonSTU Prof. G.G. Litvinsky, the Dean of the Faculty of Construction of SPSU Prof.

P.A. Demenkov, the Dean of the Faculty of Mining of DonSTU, Associate Professor P.N. Shulgin, Associate Professor of the Department of Construction and Geocontrol of the Anthracite Faculty of Geosystems and Geocontrol of LSU named after V. Dal I.A. Dudka, the Deputy Chairman of Gortekhnadzor of the DPR S.D. Skripka.

At the plenary session presentations of leading miners-researchers were done. They became a «master-class» for students and young scientists, who have taken part in the forum for the first time. Associate Professor of the Department of Energy and Mechanical Systems of DONNTU V.S. Kolomiets spoke about the promising technology of coal excavation on low-power steep formations. G. Solovyov, PhD student of the Department of Mining Development devoted his presentation to the issues of ensuring the sustainability of deep coal mine workings. Associate Professor of the Department of Construction and Geocontrol of the Anthracite Faculty of Geosystems and Geocontrol of Luhansk State University named after V. Dal I.V. Dudka drew attention to a number of problems that may arise in the process of eliminating the vertical barrel.

At the breakout sessions, the speakers spoke about the features of geomechanical monitoring of the territories to be worked and studies of deformations of the pile-base system. They raised questions related to the return of anthropogenic -disturbed lands to the recreation zones and the increase in the efficiency of working out the cultivated industrial field.

Problems of forecasting the consequences of the liquidation of coal mines; increasing the efficiency of the drilling tool in the conduct of mining operations and improving the technology of their attachment, features of studies of mechanical characteristics of modified concrete and modeling of options for the development of open and underground mining operations were paid special attention to. The state and prospects of production of safety explosives in the DPR and LPR, new ways to extract the mounts of extinguished mine workings; problems arising in the mining of mercury deposits and rock salt were discussed.

The issues related to teaching of humanitarian disciplines («Linguistics», «Linguistics», «Intercultural communication») with the features of scientific communication and the use of mountain terminology, etc. have been considered for the first time at the forum «Problems of Mining». It should be noted that this year the forum has been attended by representatives of the North Caucasus Federal University, Omsk State University of Railways, the Priargunsk Mining and Chemical Association named after H.E. Slavsky, Dhaka National University (Bangladesh).

The final session of the round table summarized the results of the breakout sessions, discussed issues of international cooperation and possible changes in the organization of the next forum.

Associate Professor of DONNTU Participates in XII International Scientific Conference at Russian Economic University named after G.V. Plekhanov (Moscow)

On March 23-24, G.V. Plekhanov's Russian Economic University held the XII International Scientific and Practical Conference of A.I. Kitov «Information Technologies and Mathematical Methods in Economy and Management» (IT and MM-2023). It was attended by leading scientists, IT specialists and academics of the Russian Academy of Sciences. The expert community discussed the creation and use of information technologies and mathematical methods in the field of economics, management and education. One of the basic vectors of the conference was the construction in Russia and partner countries of a single digital space of economic interaction based on own national projects, software and IT-specialists.

Associate Professor of the Department of Software Engineering named after L.P. Feldman of the Faculty of Intelligent Systems and Programming of Donetsk National Technical University O.I. Fedyaev spoke in a remote format at a breakout session of the conference with the report: «Visual Control of Students' Presence in the Audience by Neural Network Recognition of Faces in Images from the Video Stream», which presents the results of the development and application of computer vision for automatic recording in the electronic journal of presence (absence or lateness) of students in the training session.

Interesting reports on topical areas of digital economy and digital business development were presented at the plenary session of the conference. In particular, the reports were made by the academician of the Russian Academy of Sciences, the director of the FIC «Informatics and Management of the Russian Academy of Sciences», the Dean of Moscow State University named after M.V. Lomonosov I.A. Sokolov («On the Training of Personnel in the Field of Artificial Intelligence»), the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Institute of Information Society Development Y.E. Khokhlov («Digital Transformation of Economic Sectors, Social Sectors and Public Administration System of the Russian Federation»), the Head of Business Area «1C» LLC S.A. Lebedev («Technologies and Solutions 1C for Development of Business Digitalization and Training Practices»), the General Director of the Company «Loginom» A.I. Arustamov («Loginom Solutions for Deep Data Analysis»), as well as the heads of a number of leading Russian IT companies.

The session in the format of the «round table» was devoted to the scientific heritage of the outstanding scientist in the field of mathematics, cybernetics and information technologies Victor Mikhailovich Glushkov, the centenary of whose birth is celebrated in 2023. His daughter Prof. O.V. Kitova, the Head of the Department of Informatics of REU named after G.V. Plekhanov, spoke about the creative way of her father - the pioneer of computer science and cybernetics, who is known for his scientific results of world importance in mathematics, computer science and cybernetics, computer technology and programming. In 1998, the international organization IEEE Computer Society awarded V.M. Glushkov the medal «Computer Pioneer» for developing the theory of digital automation devices, creation of multiprocessor macro-configuration super-computers and establishment of the Institute of Cybernetics of Ukraine. It is the most important Computer Science award ever given to just a few dozen people in the world.

Professors of DONNTU Participate in Moscow Economic Forum

At the beginning of April 2023 the Head of the Department of «Business and Personnel Management» I. A. Kondaurova and Professor of the Department I.V. Kochura took part in the Moscow Economic Forum 2023, which was held in Moscow.

On April 4 -5th Moscow Economic Forum MEF-2023 was held with great success at the Central Business House in Moscow. The success of the forum was due to a rich program, especially in the new conditions of the rapidly changing world, primarily the world economy, the emerging acute need for import substitution, reorientation not only of the Russian, but also the entire world economy, de-dollarization of Russia and many other countries of the world, increased role of economic cooperation with China. All these and many other issues were discussed at Moscow Economic

Forum, attracting a lot of attention of media, society, subject experts, economists and financiers. Experts of the Forum discussed industrial development projects, which are able even in today's difficult situation to get the domestic economy out of the crisis and ensure the growth of prosperity of the population.

The first plenary meeting of the forum on the opening day of the MEF was attended by a record number of forum participants. In the huge hall of the DPC there was not a single empty seat. Because of the abundance of press it was very difficult to get to a normal place to take a photo.

According to the organizers, over 1.500 people took part in MEF-2023 during 2 days, more than 130 journalists worked, including representatives of European, Asian and Middle Eastern media. During 2 days of the Forum, more than 100 speakers from 20 countries made presentations: Russia, Brazil, India, France, China, Moldova, Germany, etc. The programme of the Forum included 3 plenary discussions, 19 thematic round tables and sessions.

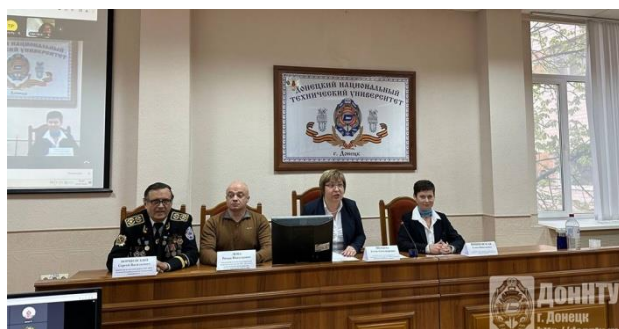

More than 100 abstracts from representatives of leading educational institutions, state and municipal authorities of the Russian Federation, including Donetsk, Lugansk, Simferopol, Yekaterinburg, Nizhny Novgorod, Novochoerkassk, and Uzbekistan, including Tashkent had been submitted.

According to the results of the conference it is planned to publish an electronic version of the conference materials in 2 volumes: in the database of «Russian Index of Scientific Citation» (RISC) and in the electronic archive of DONNTU.

IX International Scientific Conference «Man and Society at the Crossroads of Epochs: Search for Development Strategy» at DONNTU

On April 21 Donetsk National Technical University held the IX International Scientific

The relevance of the problem is due to the fact that the focus of scientific research is on understanding of the factors that determine the course of social and historical development.

The initiators of the event were the Department of Philosophy of DONNTU, the Department of Philosophy and the Department of Legal and

Political Sciences of M. Tugan-Baranovsky University, the Department of History of

Philosophy and Culture of VSU (Voronezh), the Department of Philosophy, Culture and Science of BGIK (Mr. Belgorod). The purpose of the project is to form a permanent mechanism of feedback between the university community and the state authorities, to identify the tasks that require solutions and perspective directions of development of the higher education. The first round of interviews will take place from 13 April to 28 April. Respondents will answer questions on the quality of education, media consumption, social and psychological well-being and other topics. In 2023, polls will also be held in May, September, October and November.

IV International Young History Researchers Competition Results
