



DONNTU's Delegation Takes Part in Opening Ceremony of XVIII International Forum-Contest of Students and Young Researchers "Topical Issues of Subsoil Use"

The opening ceremony of the XVIII International Forum-Contest of Students and Young Researchers "Topical Issues of Subsoil Use" took place at St. Petersburg Mining University on the 16th of May. The event was organized under the aegis of the UNESCO Competences International Centre in a hybrid format: offline and online through the videoconference system.

There were 15 members in Donetsk National Technical University's team – teachers, postgraduate and undergraduate students. The major part of the presentations prepared by DONNTU's young researchers was in the online format.

The jury members were from Moscow, St. Petersburg, Tomsk, Donetsk, and other cities.

The Donetsk People's Republic was represented by the Dean of Engineering and Economic Faculty, the Head of the Department of Economics and Management Dr. A. Kravchenko and the Deputy Dean Dr. E. Polyakova.

The Master's student of the Faculty A. Ashikhman made her presentation "Aspects of Sustainable Economic Development of Fuel and Energy Complex Enterprises».

The experts- jury members from DONNTU-summed up the breakup group work at the end of the day.

Students, postgraduates and experts from 19 countries of the world took part at the event. The DPR's representatives, who, despite the war and political situation, keep on doing research because of its crucial importance for the future of the Donbass, were paid special attention to. The DONNTU's Vice-Rector in Research Prof. S.V. Borshchevski did an interview to the program "Vesti" of the TV Channel "Russia-24" in which he reminded that the region would be reconstructed for the third time, and it would require the corresponding scientific support. Professionals having degrees in engineering will play a key role in the process. People of the DPR will not be alone in their preparation work. Firstly, they will take part in the program "Double Degree" and have their degree diplomas of the Russian format, and secondly, there will be a partner university from Russia to supervise every university from the DPR. Thus St. Petersburg Mining University took DONNTU under its patronage.

There were 22 main breakup groups at the Forum. Young researchers from DONNTU took part in seven of them: "Promising Technical and Technological Solution in Well Construction"; "Technological Process and Equipment for Beneficiation of Mineral Deposits, Metallurgy and their Physical and Chemical Basics", "Technologies of Extraction of Solid Minerals; Industrial safety and Labour Protection"; "Geological Mechanics and Mining Survey in Mining and Underground Construction"; Economics of Sustainable Development and Global Investment Trends"; "Information and Telecommunication Technologies and Digital Transformation"; "Innovations and Mining Manufacturing Development Perspectives". 15 presentations were made there. According to the decision of the competent jury 10 participants from DONNTU were announced winners, and it proves a high level of the developments in the university. V. Sadrieva and M. Priboywon the nomination "The Best Bachelor's Student"; A. Bratchenko, N. Verbitskaya, and A. Ashikhman won the nomination "The Best Master's Student"; A. Gritsaenko, A. Kolomoets, I. Chernyshenko, Y. Turulina, I. Matyakh, and M. Krokhal won the nomination "The Best Postgraduate Student". DONNTU's academics A. Karakozov, S. Borshchevski, A. Ryazanov, I. Shcherbov, K. Marenich, E. Alexeeva, A. Korchevski, A. Kravchenko, T. Vasyaeva, A. Novikov, V. Kuppenko, V. Kochura, E. Polyakova, and O. Krivodubski were members of the international jury.

The event participants had an excursion in the museum "Breakdown of Blockade of Leningrad" and to the Fortress Oreshek. These are two significant places related to the heroic defense of Leningrad during the years of its blockade.

Both students and teachers emphasize a hearty welcome they received from their Russian colleagues and especially from the Forum organizers. The cooperation with teachers from a number of universities and institutions from the Russian Federation, countries from near and far abroad that took part in the Forum will go on.

VIII International Scientific Forum "Innovation Perspectives of Donbass: Infrastructural, Social, and Economic Development" at DONNTU

There was a plenary meeting of the VIII International Scientific Forum of the Donetsk People's Republic "Innovation Perspectives of the Donbass: Infrastructural, Social, and Economic Development" at DONNTU on May 24th both in the offline and online format. Like in the previous years, DONNTU was its central venue.

The Ministry of Education and Science of the DPR was its organizer. It was the first time when St. Petersburg University has taken an active part in it.

The Minister of Education and Science Mr. M. Kushakov, leaders and representatives of other ministries and agencies, national and foreign educational and research institutions, industrial companies and high technology business (engineering entrepreneurship) and new managers of projects of infrastructural, social, and economic development of the Donbass were the Forum participants. 660 people had been registered for it.

This year's main topic was related to the Donbass recovery and reconstruction of its economic potential within a short period of time.

The Rector of DONNTU Prof. A. Anoprienko greeted the participants at the opening ceremony.

The Head of the Republic Mr. Pushilin sent a video greeting to the Forum in which he said that the traditional form of the event was very important for the DPR as crucial issues related to the Republic's development were discussed and accumulated experience was accumulated there. He also emphasized the special role the oldest and the most authoritative Russian university- St Petersburg Mining University (SPMU)- plays in the event organization and further cooperation.

SPMU's Rector Prof. V. Litvinenko thanked Mr. Kushakov, Prof. Anoprienko, and the organizing Committee for holding the event which, on his opinion, will become a reference point of the plans for the nearest years and its implementation. According to the professor mineral resources of any region, including those of the Donbass, is a natural capital which can be actualized only by the innovation environment. The DPR's resource potential is extremely rich and meets the standards of the

Russian Federation. As far as cooperation with DONNTU is concerned, the Mining University is ready to invest own and attract extra budgetary funds to modernize engineering education in the Donbass with, of course, active assistance of the DPR's government.

Mr. Kushakov also greeted the participants with the Forum opening. He said that its main task was to form the Donbass development prospects vision. Revival of the Republic is impossible without a public discussion of the Region's problems. The Minister thanked SPMU for its full support in solving educational and research tasks.

The meeting which took place in the Donetsk Botanical Garden on May 26th summed up the three-day scientific basic VIII International scientific Forum of the Donetsk People's Republic "Innovation prospects of the Donbass: Infrastructural and Social and Economic Development".

Prof. S. Borshchevski from DONNTU greeted the participants. He emphasized that the Forum results were aimed at making the Donbass the flourishing territory and giving Donetsk the status of a million of roses back.

Prof. Labinski from DONNTU summed up the Forum work. He emphasized the unique chance the Donbass had to start its revival from scratch taking into account the mistakes made by the Russian Federation the

53 papers from 10 universities of the DPR, Russia, and Belarus had been submitted to the conference. These are Donetsk National Technical University, St. Petersburg Mining University, Starooskolsk Technological Institute named after A. Ugarov, Nizhegorodski State University named after

R. Alxeev, South-Ural State University, Kuban State Technological University,

Belarus National Technical University, Makeevka Transport and Technological College, and Yenakievo Metallurgical College.

Dr. Kochura from DONNTU made his presentation “The Role of the Faculty of Metallurgy and Thermal Power in Revival of the Donbass Metallurgy” at the plenary meeting. The platform WEBEX was used.

The priority spheres in the Donbass metallurgy are as follows:

- 1) Improvement of preparation of iron-ore materials and coke for blast-furnace fusion; usage of high parameter combined blowing;
- 2) Improvement of basic oxygen steel making technology and blank continuous casting technologies;
- 3) Improvement of steel making in arc electric furnaces, electroslag technologies and materials to fuse and cast rapidly wearing equipment parts;
- 4) Improvement of cast technological process and quality of works;
- 5) Improvement of rolled sheet, pipes, and pressed-rolled railway wheels making;
- 6) Development of technologies and equipment for thermal and deformation and thermal treatment of works, technologies for anticorrosive protection of parts, tools and metal structures;
- 7) Improvement of coal firing in boiler units, rise of heat supply system efficiency, and energy efficiency and saving in the national economy;
- 8) Reduction of harmful emission under metal making, waste processing and improvement of accident prevention and fire safety in metallurgy.

DONNTU Holds VIII International Scientific and Practical Conference “Modern Public and Municipal Administration: Problems, Technologies, and Prospects”

On May 26th DONNTU held the VIII International Scientific and Practical Conference “Modern Public and Municipal Administration: Problems, Technologies, and Prospects”.

The event goal was to exchange experience in public and municipal administration, to discuss problems and principles of development of practice and technologies of the public administration, and to publish the results of scientific and practical achievements.

Two breakup groups discussed the issues of theoretical and methodological basics and

implementation of the public administration, its scientific, methodological and information support, and innovation development of state and regional economics.

More than 100 theses from key universities, institutions, and public and municipal boards from the DPR, the LPR, Russia, and Uzbekistan had been submitted. The two volume e-proceedings are to be published at the RISC data base and the DONNTU's e-archive.

DONNTU Holds XXII International Scientific and Technical Conference “Technological Object and Process Automation. Youth Search”

The XXII International Scientific and Technical Conference “Technological Object and Process Automation: Youth Search” was one of the central events of the VIII International Scientific Forum of the DPR “Donbass Innovation Prospects” traditionally held at Donetsk National Technical University.

As in previous years, the Conference was of great interest for researchers, postgraduates and students of the DPR, the RF, and Belarus. There were five breakup groups where 89 presentations were made by colleagues from Moscow, St. Petersburg, Minsk, Penza, Ufa, and Samara. 57 of them were from DONNTU.

The presentations covered the issues of improvement of information and telecommunication technologies, automation, electric equipment and means of

production and technological process control including power consuming branches, new electron information and measurement means and systems, information safety technical means innovation development. The topicality, high level and information intensity of the presentations should be mentioned.

The conference was both in online and offline formats. The DONNTU's university-supervisor St. Petersburg

Mining University offered its invaluable help providing reliable communication on the WELEX platform due to which many regions of the Russian Federation were able to take part in the Conference. The time length of communication and the number of participants connected to it were maximum possible.

The plenary meeting took into account the scientific and educational activity of DONNTU and SPMU and the characteristics of the Donbass branches structure. There

were presentations on the developments crucially important to raise efficiency and safety of operation of the Donbass fuel and energy complex companies, and coal enterprises in particular.

Thus Dr. Dubinka talked on workers electric injuries caused by reverse energy flows after mine process installation powerful induction motors turning off. Dr. Gulyaeva spoke on the effect of electricity injuries factor because of mine parts electric equipment grounding through flexible cable central conductors and justified the principle change in the approach of the earthing grid design and wide application of the local means of automatic control of the circuit of “phase- electrical installation hull”. Dr. Sharnopolskaya spoke on technical and economic aspects and ecological affects of usage of renewable electric power in the Donbass. She also justified rational niches to use solar wind power stations and feasibility of power supply of powerful and power-consuming production including 11 category consumers (which is crucial for the Donbass branches) from thermal stations with the main effort made to implement fuel combustion efficient technologies, improve technical means to recover, use and burry hothouse gas. The authors of the presentations showed their own developments to solve topical scientific and technical tasks.

The online panel discussion proved the topicality of the subject-matter and acceptability of the proposed technical and economic solutions.

The developments of researchers, postgraduates and students discussed at the conference are another step to raise efficiency of technological process based on improvement of automation means, power supply and control systems. The final conclusions and recommendations of the conference participants were included into the memorandum of the VIII International scientific Forum of the DPR “Innovation Perspectives of the Donbass”.

DONNTU’s Teachers Take Refresher Courses “Topical Issues of Russian Language and Literature Teaching: Psychological, Pedagogic and Methodological Support”

On May 26th DONNTU’s teachers Machai, Shevchenko, Yurieva, and Yushkova took online refresher courses “Topical Issues of the Russian language and Literature Teaching: Psychological, Pedagogic, and Methodological Support” at South Federal University (Rostov-on-Don).

The participants were greeted by Mr. Kushakov, the Minister of Education and Science of the DPR; Ms. Borovskaya, the head of the Rectors Council of the South of Russia and the President of South Federal University; Mr. Bondarev, the Vice-Rector in Projects of South Federal University; Mr. Kirik, the Director of the Academy of Psychology and Pedagogic of South Federal University; Ms. Lomakina, the Director of the Institute of Philology, Journalism, and Inter-Cultural Communication of South Federal University.

Our teachers got invaluable experience and knew knowledge which Russian colleagues shared with them.

Dean of Mining faculty of DONNTU Wins Contest “Quality National Certificate”

The International Association of Teachers and Professionals (The Russian Academy of Natural Science) held a professional contest “The Quality National Certificate” in April. The Dean of the Mining Faculty of DONNTU Dr. Korchevski took part in it. His monograph “Application of Process and Devices of Vibration and Pneumatic Dressing of Raw Material Resources” was the winner in the nomination “The Best Information Product”.

Dr. Korchevski and Mr. Kholodov (DONNTU), and Prof. Vorobyov from Russian University of People's Friendship (Moscow) got the certificate in the nomination “Science and Engineering”.

The monograph covered the issues of development of scientific foundations and methods to investigate a number of minerals concentration processes to improve technological schemes and justify the parameters which provide making efficiency and product high quality. It presents process mathematical models, justifies modern methods to calculate technological scheme parameters, and offers ways to modernize enrichment technologies and equipment.

Dr. Korchevski is the Head of the Department where new technology of coal sludge enrichment based on a new concentration desk has been developed. The tests of enrichment of grainy coal sludge of anthropogenic waste on the concentration desks of the type of СКОБ-2. 5*2(3) M took place at the industrial venue of the dressing works branch “Vostok-Yug” in Novoshakhtinsk, the company “ProfLine”, Shakhty, in Rostov Region of the RF. The results of research of different modes of the concentration desk operation with vibration biharmonic mode show wide possibilities of the device under different raw material separation. The great number of parameters to regulate the desk helps control the process of rock and coal particles separation and find the operation rational mode.

Thus the developed construction and technology can be recommended to the application with different goals not only for coal dressing but also for other materials gravitation separation.

The industrial test report and the annual economic effect regulation were signed on behalf of DONNTU, the company “Resource Engineering” (Donetsk), and the company “ProfLine” (Shakhty).

STL of DONNTU is Diplomat of XIII International Action “Reading to Children about the Great Patriotic War”

This year, the Scientific and Technical Library of Donetsk National Technical University has become a traditional participant in the XIII International Action “Reading Children about the Great Patriotic War”, initiated by Samara Regional

Children's Library, which was held on May 5. The main idea of the event is to read aloud and review works, which reflect more expressive and memorable episodes of the
