



Jubilee X Forum “Engineers of Future” with participation of DONNTU’s Rector Prof. Anoprienko

Back in 2011, the first International Forum "Engineers of the Future 2011" was held in the Irkutsk region on Lake Baikal, which brought together young specialists working in the Russian industry, as well as students of technical universities in Russia, near and far abroad. The organizers of the Forum,

which was attended by thousands of participants from hundreds of industrial companies and universities from 50 countries, were the Union of Machine Builders of Russia and the Government of the Irkutsk Region.

Subsequently, the Forum, which became an annual event, was held in various places in Russia. In 2021, the jubilee X Forum was to be held in a picturesque place near the village of Bunyrevno, where a small river Vashana flows into the Oka, at the recreation center "Miner" in the Aleksinsky district of the Tula Region. But due to the pandemic, the anniversary forum was postponed to 2022 and was inaugurated on June 29.

At the opening ceremony, the guests were welcomed by Yuri Ivanovich Borisov (Deputy Prime Minister of the Russian Federation) and the Governor of the Tula Region Alexey Gennadievich Dyumin, who did a lot to ensure that the X Forum "Engineers of the Future" was held at the highest level and became not only a wonderful place for learning, communication and exchange of experience for thousands of young engineers and students of technical universities, but also a grandiose holiday, memorable for a long time.

Almost a whole city has been developed from a variety of wooden cottages with all amenities in a pine forest, tents for the parallel holding of many educational and business events, as well as exhibition and concert venues on the vast territory of the recreation center "Miner". The numerous scooters and bicycles that the forum participants can use to move around its vast territory only emphasize the dynamism of everything that is happening.

During the opening ceremony, the flags of the participating countries and the subjects of the Federation that took part in the Forum were also ceremonially carried out. The abundance of flags clearly testified to the scale of the event: about 50 from the subjects of the Federation and about the same number from the

participating countries, among which Belarus, Kazakhstan, Serbia, India and other countries of Asia, Africa and Eastern Europe were represented. The flag of the Donetsk People's Republic (DPR) was also present at the ceremony: several graduate students of Donetsk National Technical University (DONNTU), headed by the Rector of the University Alexander Yakovlevich Anoprienko, who, due to the impossibility of graduate students leaving because of the difficult situation in the Republic, had to represent the DPR for the first time at the anniversary Forum, received an invitation to participate in the Forum.

It should be noted that DONNTU already has more than a quarter of a century of experience in holding such Forums, much smaller and focused mainly on teachers and graduate students of technical universities, but with very broad international participation. They are called "Mechanical Engineering and the Technosphere of the XXI Century" and are held under the auspices of the International Union of Machine Builders. Since Sevastopol State Technical University was among the first co-organizers of this Forum, they are usually held in Sevastopol. Among other co-organizers and participants of the Forum were also dozens of universities in Russia (in particular, Tula University) and Eastern Europe. This Forum has successfully survived the events of 2014 and will be held for the 29th time in September 2022. That is why, with such increased interest, the Rector of DONNTU took part in the Forum "Engineers of the Future", held under the auspices of the Union of Machine Builders of Russia.

The DPR delegation of 4 people, including 2 young teachers, was also represented at the Forum.

The Rector of DONNTU Alexander Yakovlevich Anoprienko was given the opportunity to hold a round table for the Forum participants on the topic "Patterns of Technological Development and Engineering Activities".

This topic has been discussed for a number of years at the conference "Mechanical Engineering and the Technosphere of the XXI Century", as well as at various other engineering forums, invariably arousing high interest among listeners.

Interest in this topic was also manifested in the fact that the Russian Society "Knowledge" offered to additionally record about a 20-minute presentation on this topic for the marathon "Engineers of the Future". Fragments of this recording also appeared on a number of news sites.

The Rector of DONNTU also acted as an expert in the field of Robotics and Artificial Intelligence at the National Scientific and Technical Conference held within the framework of the Forum to defend projects.

In general, this first experience of participating in such a large-scale engineering youth forum can be considered another important step towards the integration of DPR universities into the Russian scientific, educational and engineering space. There is a well-founded hope that a fairly representative team of the Donetsk People's Republic will be able to take part in the next forum "Engineers of the Future".

Rector of DONNTU Expresses Gratitude to Administration of St. Petersburg Mining University

This year, as a part of the developing cooperation between our universities, students of Donetsk National Technical University for the first time took part in summer schools, which were organized at St. Petersburg Mining University by the International Competence Center in Mining Education under the auspices of the UNESCO.

At DONNTU, the selection of participants was held on a competitive basis, which made it possible to attract the most motivated students to the development of short-term educational programs. As a result, 44 students took part in five summer schools in such areas as "Modern Mining Technologies", "Digital Mining Production", "Oil

and Gas Well Construction Technologies", "Engineering Geodesy: Theory and Practice" and "Chemical Engineering in Oil and Gas business".

Lectures and practical classes, master classes and trainings were organized for the participants, which were held in specialized classrooms under the guidance of leading employees of the Mining University. It was planned to visit modern industrial facilities: the service center of the Zeppelin Company, the Vyborg Career Administration, the plant for the production of drilling equipment and others. The two-week programs are practice-oriented and reflect current trends in the development of mineral raw materials industries.

Participation in summer schools is great opportunities for DONNTU students to develop previously formed and acquire additional competencies in the field of future professional activity.

Teaching Staff of DONNTU Completes Internship at St. Petersburg Mining University

On July 1, the internship of scientific and pedagogical workers of Donetsk National Technical University ended at St. Petersburg Mining University.

During the month, four groups of DONNTU teachers, 240 people, underwent a week-long full-time training on the course "Professional Teacher". The purpose of the program is to improve the qualification level of the teaching staff, taking into account the qualification requirements for professional knowledge and skills necessary for the performance of official duties.

During lectures and practical classes, master classes and trainings conducted by leading teachers of the Mining University, DONNTU employees received additional knowledge on the regulatory and legal foundations of the education system of the Russian Federation, as well as skills and abilities in the field of

planning and implementation of the educational process, practical psychology, rhetoric and ethics of communication, aimed at improving the effectiveness of educational activities.

According to the results of mastering the theoretical part of the program, all teachers of

DONNTU successfully passed the intermediate certification – differentiated credit in the form of testing. Individual assignments were received, according to the results of which the final certification for the course "Professional Teacher" will take place in the autumn of this year.

Professional development is an integral part of the cooperation plan of partner universities - Donetsk National Technical University and St. Petersburg Mining University, the implementation of which is aimed at humanizing society and intensifying the economic development of the Republics of Donbass through the training of qualified, meeting modern requirements engineering personnel.

DONNTU Students – Participants of Summer Schools of St. Petersburg Mining University

The program of summer schools, which was organized at St. Petersburg Mining University by the International Center for Competencies in Mining Engineering Education under the auspices of UNESCO, ended on July 22.

This year, more than 800 students and postgraduates from Belarus, Armenia, Kazakhstan, Namibia, India, China, Donetsk and Lugansk People's Republics and 40 Russian universities belonging to the Nedra consortium have become participants in short-term educational programs in full-time and distance formats.

The programs had been developed by leading teachers and staff of St. Petersburg Mining University, as well as invited experts.

44 students of Donetsk National Technical University were given the opportunity to take part in the summer schools full-time. In the first wave, from June 27 to July 8, students mastered the programs "Modern Mining Technologies", "Digital Mining Production" and "Oil and gas Well Construction Technologies", and from

July 11 to 22 – "Engineering Geodesy: Theory and Practice" and "Chemical Engineering in Oil and Gas Business".

The selection of participants of summer schools was held on a competitive basis, which made it possible to attract the most motivated students who could adequately withstand the high intensity of the educational process.

The programs included lectures and practical classes, master classes and trainings, independent work and final certification. The training took place using high-tech laboratory facilities in specialized classes of scientific centers of St. Petersburg Mining University.

Visits to training and production sites and leading enterprises of the city and region were also carried out. The students visited the Sablino training base, where they got acquainted with the drilling rig fleet, the drilling equipment production plant, the Vyborg Career Administration, the Zeppelin Rusland service center and other industrial facilities.

The excursion program of the summer schools allowed all participants to plunge into the history and culture of St. Petersburg.

Students of Donetsk National Technical University not only acquired additional theoretical knowledge and practical skills in the field of professional activity, but also had a great time in the Northern capital of Russia.

Cooperation Agreement between DONNTU and Chuvash State University Named after I.N. Ulyanov and CHEAZ is Signed

On July 25, the administration of the Head of the Donetsk People's Republic signed a trilateral agreement on cooperation among Donetsk National Technical University, Chuvash State University named after I. N. Ulyanov, and Cheboksary Electrical Equipment Plant Joint Stock Company.

The agreement provides for the following tasks of joint interaction of the parties:

- Cooperation in the training and development of human resources in the field of education, research and development; in the creation of a modern infrastructure of scientific research and world-class scientific and educational centers; in the development of innovative activities;
- Development and strengthening of academic and pedagogical cooperation, including the exchange of experience and information on curricula, methodological manuals in the field of higher education;
- Assistance in strengthening and developing contacts and ties between organizations and methodological

associations of the relevant orientation;

– organization and holding of joint events (contests, exhibitions, including field trips, conferences, round tables, master classes and others) of mutual interest.

After signing the agreement, representatives of Chuvash State University named after I.N. Ulyanov, the Rector A.Y. Alexandrov and the Vice-Rector for Research E.N. Kadyshev visited Donetsk National Technical University, got acquainted with the history of the university and the laboratory base of the departments of the Faculty of Intelligent Electric Power Engineering and Robotics.

As part of the exchange of views, the parties came to the conclusion that in order to ensure the development of the scientific and educational potential of the Russian Federation and the Donetsk People's Republic, the possibility of creating a consortium with the involvement of educational, scientific, financial and other organizations interested in the program could be considered.

New Cooperation Agreement between DONNTU and Ufa State Petroleum Technical University

The cooperation agreement between Donetsk National Technical University and Ufa State Petroleum Technical University (USPTU) was signed on August 4 in the videoconference format. The document was signed by the Rectors of universities A.Y. Anoprienko and O.A. Baulin. The event was attended by the Vice-Rector of DONNTU A.N. Ryazanov, as well as the Vice-Rector for Educational and Methodological Work A.I. Moguchev, Vice-Rector for Scientific and Innovative Work R.U. Rabaev and the Vice-Rector for International Development N.T. Chanshev, who represented USPTU.

The purpose of the signed agreement is to develop cooperation between universities in the educational and scientific fields of activity. USPTU trains specialists and conducts scientific research in the field of drilling, development and production of oil and gas, their transportation, storage and processing, synthesis of new materials, improving corrosion resistance and durability

of petrochemical, oilfield and oil and gas transportation equipment, development of building materials and technological processes.

The approved plan of joint activities of the two universities for the period up to August 2023 is focused on the practical implementation of the agreements reached. It includes training, industrial practices and internships for students, postgraduates, teaching staff, as well as the joint organization of additional education and research.

WE REMEMBER! WE GRIEVE!

On July 31, 2022, Vadim Ivanovich Strelnikov, Candidate of Technical Sciences, Associate Professor, Professor of the Department of Mineral Deposits Development of the Mining Faculty of DONNTU, passed away.

Vadim Ivanovich was born in 1938 in the village of Pokrovskoye, Dnipropetrovsk Region. In 1956 he graduated from school with honors, and in 1961 – the Mining Faculty of Donetsk Polytechnic Institute.

Vadim Ivanovich has been working since 1961: At first, he was an engineer and senior engineer of the Research Institute (1961-1964) and from 1964 to 1969 – an Assistant Professor at the RMPI Department. In 1968 he defended his PhD thesis and in 1971 became an Associate Professor of this department. In 1972-1973, in addition to teaching, he worked as a Deputy Dean of the Mining Faculty.

From 1972 to 2004 he worked as the Dean of Education for Foreign Students of the University. The Dean for the Education of Foreign students, together with the entire faculty of the DPI, was engaged in a matter of national importance: the training of engineering personnel for foreign countries.

Foreign students could not only study, but also relax by the sea; during their holidays they traveled to the capitals of the Union republics; they could see Lake Baikal, a region closed to foreigners at that time, and many other interesting

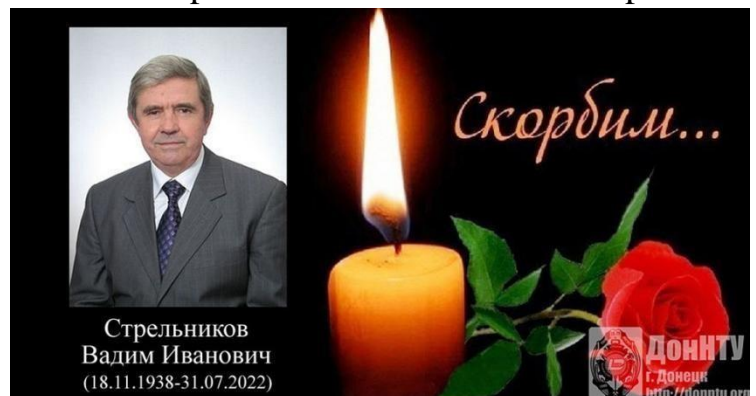

places. It was a whole program, in the implementation of which the participation of Dean V.I. Strelnikov was direct. He organized these trips and traveled with students to cities and villages himself. A separate period of his life was the construction of the Interclub. The construction was not without difficulties. Construction materials had to be "knocked out" by special order letters. Vadim Ivanovich mastered this business. He managed to introduce foreign students to our purely tradition of subbotniks, to which all the communities came out and built. The Interclub has been a real international house in Donetsk for many years.

Few people know about such an aspect of Dean's activity as correspondence with graduates. V.I. Strelnikov is perhaps the only Dean who answered every letter of a graduate, wrote them greeting cards for national holidays and birthdays, and sent technical literature on the specialty both personally to graduates and to libraries of cultural centers and Embassies of the USSR in foreign countries.

From 2005 to 2013 he worked as First Deputy Director of the DONNTU Institute of International Cooperation. Vadim Ivanovich Strelnikov was awarded the Order of Friendship of Peoples for his high achievements in international work with students. His contribution to the development of international cooperation of Donetsk National Technical University is huge.

His name was known far beyond the borders of our university and the Donetsk People's Republic. Vadim Ivanovich was a highly qualified specialist in mining. His research interests were technology of underground mining of coal deposits, computer systems for designing mines, computer modeling of production processes, economic assessment of technological processes. He was the Head of the Research Board, according to the results of which he published scientific articles, abstracts and reports at conferences of various levels in collaboration with students.

For more than 10 years he had been lecturing and conducting practical classes with mining students in German. V.I. Strelnikov's lectures were distinguished by high culture and original presentation of the material. They focused on the latest scientific developments, used technical training tools. Practical classes and course design, conducted according to real mining documentation, taught students to solve specific production tasks.

Vadim Ivanovich had extensive experience in methodological work. He developed the course programs "Fundamentals of Mining Production", "Technology and Mechanization of Mining Operations", published a manual in the form of a collection of television screensavers for lectures at the television center. His methodological materials were distinguished by the logical presentation and in-depth study of the educational material prepared on the basis of real mining and geological conditions of the mines of Donbass. Dr. Strelnikov also developed computer training programs and a textbook on determining the cost of certain types of mining operations during course and diploma design, which improves the quality of students' research.

He actively participated in research work on the state and contractual topics, and prepared for publication a Ukrainian-German and German-Ukrainian dictionary of mining terms, was the co-author of a textbook and textbooks, the author of dozens

of articles on mining problems. He also worked out the training programs of the courses "Technology of Underground Mining" and "Fundamentals of Mining" (for the specialties "Economics and Organization of Mining Industry" and "Management of Enterprises (Mining Industry)") and compiled a complete set of educational and methodological documentation.

The whole life of Vadim Ivanovich testified that he was an excellent example of a teacher and a scientist who successfully combines managerial and administrative work. His business and human qualities, integrity and consistency, versatile knowledge and rich life experience have earned well-deserved authority and respect from colleagues, friends and students.

In the memory of colleagues, graduates and students, Vadim Ivanovich will remain an example of high professionalism, intelligence, diligence, integrity, kindness, honesty, responsiveness and humanity.

For two weeks, students studied international business and digital economy under the guidance of leading teachers and mentors of FEFU. In addition, the participants

"UNIVERSITY online", the presented idea of the team, which included DONNTU students, entered the top 10 best projects of the "Summer University". This is a

platform for communication between students, teachers and the administration of universities of the Donetsk People's Republic, which allows you to quickly find out the necessary information regarding academic and extracurricular activities.

In addition to classroom classes, excursions, cultural and entertainment, leisure and other events were organized for the participants.

First Anniversary: Five DONNTU's Electrical Engineering Master's Defend their Works at V. G. Shukhov BSTU

In June 2022, regular defenses of students' Master's works of the Faculty of Intelligent Electric Power Engineering and Robotics (FIER) of Donetsk National Technical University were held in Belgorod State Technological University named after V. G. Shukhov. This end of the academic year has already become traditional. A total of 83 graduates have defended their Master's Works under the double degree program since 2018, 45 of them have received diplomas with honors. The annual replenishment of the ranks of the technical elite of Donbass continues.

Based on the results of the five-year work done, it can be stated that all DONNTU graduates who defended their works under the program of cooperation with V. G. Shukhov BSTU have achieved certain results. They continue their studies at postgraduate schools of their university and Russian universities, work in research institutes, commissioning and design

organizations, at large energy enterprises in Donetsk, Moscow, Moscow Region, Yekaterinburg, Rostov-on-Don and many other cities of the DPR and the Russian Federation as leading engineers and specialists exclusively in their profile.

If the electrical engineering students of our university had certain difficulties in 2018, because they were the first participants in the double degree program, then the second stream was faced with the task of keeping the bar set by the pioneers at a height. The two subsequent coronavirus years (2020 and 2021) complicated the students' task. With remote defense to reveal the essence of the work, when separate ways of communicating information are not available, the graduates began to actively use video in their demonstrations, since most of the works were not just of the research nature, but also ended with experimental studies on developed prototypes. For their demonstration, a video of the development results taken by students was used. The known circumstances of the year of 2022 restricted students' access to the laboratory. This factor did not reduce the level of defended works, but the emphasis of research was shifted in the direction of computer modeling.

The agreement on the network form of implementation of educational programs between Donetsk National Technical University and Belgorod State Technological University named after V.G. Shukhov continues to work and bring real results of effective cooperation.

Defense of Master's Works by Graduates of ARI DONNTU in Rostov-on-Don
