Cooperation between St. Petersburg Mining University and DONNTU Goes on

In the spring of this year, St. Petersburg Mining University (SPMU) took over the patronage of Donetsk National Technical University, 50 first-year students of which came to the Northern capital in September for a one-year included training. A meeting with DONNTU students was held at the Mining Museum of St. Petersburg State University, which was timed

to coincide with the presentation of certificates for included training to Donetsk first-year students and the 300th anniversary of the birth of the coal industry in Donbas. This event was the occasion for the news story of the "Vesti – Saint Petersburg" program of the Rossiya-1 TV channel.

Three hundred years ago a self-taught geologist Georgy Kapustin discovered deposits of mining coal on the territory of modern Donbas — this is how the development of black gold began in the Russian Empire. At the end of the 19th century jackhammers replaced the hacks, which in the 20th century already helped the Stakhanovites to fulfill the monthly norm per day.

St. Petersburg State University students get acquainted with the work of miners right in the university museum. Most of the exhibits are models that amaze with their detail. Now the safety of people is one of the main priorities. Future mining engineers know this from their student days. The Rector of DONNTU Prof. Anoprienko noted that an engineer should ideally study perfectly well because a lot depends on him. A mining engineer should first of all take care of the safety of work, especially when it comes to underground mining, and in the Donbas this is mainly the case.

The name of Pyotr Gorlov is on the golden honor board of SPMU. The best graduate of the Corps of Mining Engineers stood at the origins of the Donbas coal industry, which very name, is an abbreviation of the Donetsk Coal Basin, was actually invented within the walls of the SPMU, the link of Donetsk Polytechnic University with which is becoming stronger. Today, two technical universities are partners within the framework of the program of the Ministry of Science and Education of the Russian Federation, which provides comprehensive assistance from leading Russian universities to higher educational institutions of Donbas: advanced training courses, internships, included student training, implementation

of double degree programs, exchange of experience, etc.

Timur Makarov, one of the Donetsk students who arrived to study at the Mining University, has a geodesist father. The guy followed in his footsteps, he draws and paints perfectly. Student Maria Vasilkova is a hereditary miner at all. The girl chose the Faculty of Intelligent Electric Power Engineering and Robotics, as robotics is a priority for modern coal mines.

DONNTU's New Cooperation Agreements

In September, Donetsk National University signed new cooperation agreements with the following universities of the Russian Federation: Financial University

under the Government of the Russian Federation, Ufa State Aviation Technical University, St. Petersburg State University of Industrial Technologies and Design, Siberian State University of Telecommunications and Informatics.

Within the framework of cooperation between universities, it is planned to exchange students in the main educational programs and areas of training of scientific and pedagogical personnel, integration of teaching methods, advanced training, development and implementation of joint projects in various fields of activity. Issues related to joint publications, patents, scientific topics and dissertation defenses were also discussed.

From August 23 to 26, with the assistance of the RUSSIAN CENTER, representatives of higher educational institutions of the Donetsk People's Republic took part in the international forum "Technoprom – 2022", which was held in Novosibirsk.

The International Forum and Exhibition of Technological Development "Technoprom" is the largest technological event in Russia, the main purpose of which is to promote domestic scientific

developments and innovations, as well as to create conditions for accelerating scientific and technological development and operational implementation of science and technology achievements.

Representatives of Donetsk National Technical University Trained at Donskoi State Technical University

Representatives of Donbas universities, including Donetsk National Technical University, were trained at Donskoi State Technical University from September 5 to 30 under the program of additional education "Topical Issues of Teaching in Educational Institutions of Higher Education: Regulatory, Psychological, Pedagogical and Methodological Support".

Groups were formed from among the students of the courses, each of which for three days got acquainted with the key issues of the implementation of higher education in the Russian Federation: regulatory and legal aspects, psychological and pedagogical technologies and the information and educational environment.

Taking into account the fact that the effectiveness of the university's activities is largely determined by the level of qualification and competence of the teaching staff, the topic of lectures was relevant for teachers of the DPR and LPR. These are the features of accreditation and licensing of educational programs according to

Russian requirements and standards, methods of psychological support and adaptation of the educational process in the circumstances, media security and work with digital tools in the field of education, as well as the regulatory environment of education and youth policy. The lecturers of the Donskoi State Technical University tried to convey to the listeners all the


the problems of patriotic education and countering the falsification of history.

Refresher Courses for DONNTU's Students

"Social Project Activity of Youth and Development of Territories" was the name of the professional development program supported by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation at the site of the Russian State University for the Humanities, which was attended by 36 students of Donetsk National Technical University.

From July 15 to August 21, 14 lectures were held, during which participants got

acquainted with the basics of the state youth policy of the Russian Federation, the basic principles, forms, content of social project activities; mastered the management system, the main processes of projects, the basics of startup projects; studied methods for evaluating the effectiveness and efficiency of the project. Special attention was paid to the team, the manager and the



communication system in the process from the initiation of the idea to the completion of the project.

The program gave an opportunity to fully explore the life cycle of the project; experienced speakers, using their examples, told about the most effective technologies and possible unforeseen situations, and gave advice on how to avoid them.

At the moment, there are many opportunities in the Russian Federation to implement initiatives specifically by means of project activities, and the training was aimed at the competent implementation of the idea into reality.

The result of the program was the passing of certification in the form of testing. In a month participants will receive certificates, and now they can share their acquired knowledge and develop ideas for the development of the territory of their native land.
