**Representatives of DONNTU - Participants of International Forum “Nature Management and World Heritage Conservation”**

The International Forum «Nature Management and World Heritage Conservation» was held in St. Petersburg on the basis of Mining University on December 1- 4<sup>th</sup>. The event of this level has been held in Russia for the first time, and was timed to coincide with the 50th anniversary of the Convention for the Protection of the World Cultural and Natural Heritage - one of the most effective and widely recognized international instruments developed under the



UNESCO aegis. The forum was attended by more than a thousand representatives from 70 countries. They are composed of high-level politicians, scientists, managers of energy and mining companies, as well as students and post graduate students.

Taking into account the special importance of development of all-round cooperation between Donetsk National Technical University and Saint Petersburg Mining University, the

Rector of DONNTU A.Y. Anoprienko received an invitation to participate in the forum. The Donetsk delegation headed by the Rector of the Technical University included Vice-Rector A.N. Ryazanov and the Head of the Department of Occupational Safety and Aerology named after I.M. Pugach A.L. Kaver. The event and breakout sessions were attended by 10 students of DONNTU, who were invited to the SPMU to complete the program of the International Winter School «Digital Mining».

The Chairman of the Federation Council of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation Valentina Matvienko, the Russian Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov, the Deputy Prime Minister Alexander Novak, the Energy Minister Nikolai Shulginov, the Governor of Saint-Petersburg Alexander Beglov, the President of the Republic of Tatarstan Rustam Minnikhanov, the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation Valery Falkov welcomed the participants at the opening session.

The Rector of the St. Petersburg Mining University, the Chairman of the Board of Governors of the International Centre of Competence in Mining and Technical Education under the aegis of UNESCO V. S. Litvinenko addressed the delegates with a keynote presentation «Mineral Resources as Natural Capital of Planetary Importance for Sustainable Development of Society».

During the breakup group work the participants discussed such issues as public policy in ensuring a balance of interests in subsoil management; environmental management in the context of sustainable development: groundwater as the unique natural wealth and a number of others. At the breakup group meeting “Advanced Scientific Research for the Sustainable Development of the Commodity Sector» Rector of DONNTU A.I. Anoprienko made a presentation. The Vice-Rector A.N. Ryazanov took part in the discussion of the development of cooperation of universities within the «Nedra» consortium.

The forum resulted in the development of the declaration on the need to establish an international expert group to develop proposals on the principles of environmental management in the context of the preservation of cultural and natural heritage

### **DONNTU Students are Participants of International Winter School of Mining University**

Within the framework of the successfully developing cooperation between Donetsk National Technical University and Saint Petersburg Mining University 10 students of the Faculties of Mining, Subsoil Management and Earth Sciences, Information Systems and Technologies, Intelligent Systems and Programming of DONNTU took part in the International Winter School “Digital Mining” at SPMU on October 26<sup>th</sup> – December 8<sup>th</sup>.

International summer and winter schools have been implemented in the Mining University since 2018 and with the support of the International Center under the aegis of the UNESCO - since 2019.

Winter schools provide students with basic engineering training, as they are designed to acquire new professional competencies that are not included in the core curriculum.

The first stage of the training included lecture sessions on the main directions of functioning of enterprises of the mineral and raw materials complex, which were held in a remote format. The level of material mastery was determined during the intermediate testing. Students demonstrated excellent and good level of knowledge, which enabled the organizers to invite participants of the educational project to the second, in-house, stage of development of the program directly on the grounds of the Mining University (St. Petersburg).

In the period of December 1-4<sup>th</sup> the students, as a part of the DONNTU delegation, took part in the opening and breakup groups of the International Forum «Nature Management and World Heritage Conservation» timed to the 50th anniversary of the UNESCO Convention for the Protection of the World Cultural and Natural Heritage.

On December 5-8<sup>th</sup> lecture and practical classes, master classes, seminars and trainings, case competitions, sessions on the educational program were organized for students.

All DONNTU students successfully completed the training and received certificates confirming the acquisition of additional professional competencies.

### **High School Students from Donetsk Take Part in International Project with Support of DONNTU and St. Petersburg Mining University**

From November 30<sup>th</sup> till December 4<sup>th</sup>, 12 Donetsk high school students took part in the All-Russian project session for schoolchildren with the international participation «Preservation of the Natural Wealth of Russia». This was made possible by close cooperation between St. Petersburg Mining University and Donetsk National Technical University. The event was held at the Mining University under the aegis of the Russian Commission for UNESCO in St. Petersburg on the venues of the International Forum “Nature Management and World Cultural and Natural Heritage Preservation”.

The objective of the Project Session was to discuss the balance between environmental management, environmental safety and preservation of natural heritage in expanded informal communication between leading experts in these areas and school leavers.

Over the course of five days high school students from the Donetsk People’s Republic together with high school students from other regions of Russia were involved in a variety of activities, ranging from receipts to attendance at the opening of the forum, which brought together more than 80 countries.

In addition, the Mining University organized for the Donetsk people excursions on UNESCO cultural heritage objects in Saint Petersburg and the Leningrad region, including acquaintance with the historical center of the Northern Capital - Catherine Palace in Pushkin, and the university building itself.

The participation of the Donetsk students in the project was organized with the support of the Mining University given to promising young researchers with a high level of development of leadership skills and professional competencies in the field of natural resource management and preservation of the world cultural and natural heritage.

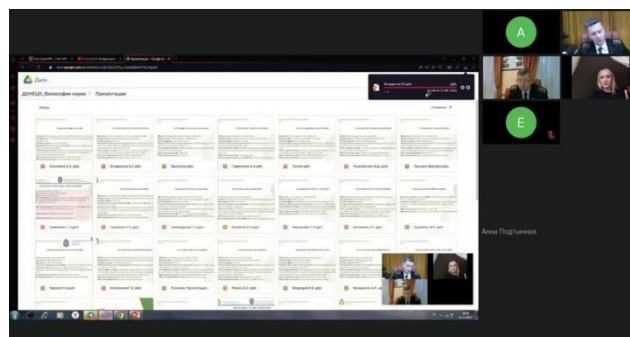
## **DONNTU Students and Postgraduates finish the Professional Competences Course “Science Philosophy” at St. Petersburg Mining University**

In April this year, students of Donetsk National Technical University took a theoretical course on the program of professional competences «Philosophy of Science». The training took place at the suggestion of Professor Vladimir Stefanovich Litvinenko, the Rector of Saint Petersburg Mining University.

The Mining University admitted two groups of 137 DONNTU representatives from the postgraduate, master's, and undergraduate courses representing all faculties. As part of the course, they were introduced to the basics of publication and patent science, as well as to the methodology of conducting experimental research.

In the subsequent period, their scientific reviews on prospective areas of research relevant to the development of the mineral and raw material complex were carried out and submitted for examination to the Mining University.

In December 43 students and graduate students from DONNTU made a remote presentation of scientific reviews before the commission from the Mining University. St. Petersburg scientists noted a fairly high level of submitted works, the possibility of their use for subsequent solution of applied scientific and industrial problems. The works of postgraduate students Maria Starhmal (Department of Computer Engineering), Anastasia Kolomoets (Department of Development of the MB), Natalia Natchkebia (Department of Technical Heat Physics), Ekaterina Bondarenko (Group of PIm-21) and Vera Ermakova (Group AUPM-21) were highlighted.



In the near future all students who have completed the surveys will receive certificates of the researcher confirming the development of initial scientific competence.

The staff of DONNTU led by the Rector A.Y. Anoprienko expresses great gratitude for the comprehensive assistance provided to the university by SPMU, and hopes that the cooperation between the two universities will be strengthened and developed.

On November 29-30<sup>th</sup> Donetsk National Technical University held the IV International Scientific and Practical Conference “Software Engineering: Methods and Technologies of Development of Information and Computer Systems” on the Basis of the Cloud Platform Mail.ru-Video Calls.

The purpose of the event was to create conditions for the exchange of new ideas, technologies and results among software engineering professionals who are directly involved in the activities of analysis, specification, design, development, certification, support and testing of software for various computer systems, as well as to enhance cooperation between specialists in industrial programming with commercial entities.

Founders and organizers - MES DPR, Donetsk National Technical University, and Department of Program Engineering named after L.P. Feldman of the Faculty of Intelligent Systems and Programming DONNTU, SRU «Moscow Institute of Electronic Engineering», Ulyanovsk State Technical University.

The partners were Donetsk National University, Ministry of Communications of the DPR, the Higher School of Cyber Technology, Mathematics and Statistics of the REU named after G.V. Plekhanov (t Moscow), the Institute of Computer Technologies and Information Security of the Southern Federal University (Taganrog), the scientific journal of DONNTU «Informatics and Cybernetics», the Institute of Artificial Intelligence (Donetsk).

The conference consisted of five scientific breakup groups: software systems, modern languages and programming technologies; information systems, databases, security and data protection; intelligent

systems, data analysis and pattern recognition; computer modeling, virtual reality, computer graphics and image processing systems; software and computer systems design, software and system computer design tools.

The event was attended by 65 people online. Within the framework of it, a scientific and practical online-seminar and breakout sessions were held at which 70 presentations were heard.

Based on the results of the work of the breakup groups, the main theoretical and methodological and practical recommendations on qualitative training of specialists in the field of software engineering were formulated. The need to involve young and prospective specialists in the development of the information and innovation sector of the Republic through participation in the implementation of informatization and digitalization projects, creating the infrastructure to include the employer in the training of software engineers was noted,

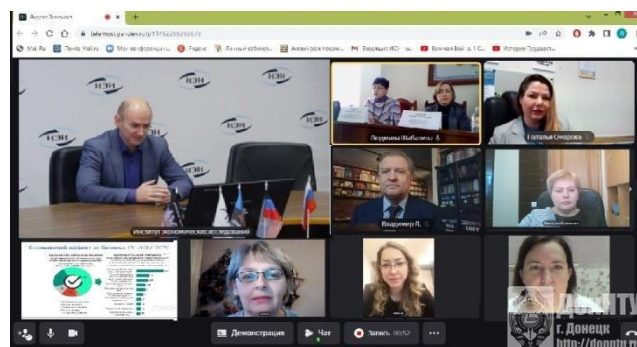

Donetsk National Technical University together with the Institute of Economic Research (DPR), the Institute of Development Studies of the Eurasian Economic Union, the Novgorod State University named after Yaroslav Mudryy and Don State Technical University held V International Scientific and Practical Conference «Modern World Economy: Challenges and Reality» on December 6<sup>th</sup>.

The Rector of DONNTU A. Anoprienko, the Associate Professor, the General Director of the Institute of the Eurasian Economic Community the political scientist, sociologist, political

figure V.L. Lelepyhin, the Director of the Institute of Economic Research, the Associate Professor A.V. Polovyan and the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering and Economics DONNTU, the Associate Professor A.A. Kravchenko welcomed the organizers and participants. All speakers stressed the importance of organizing such a discussion platform at the current stage of the integration of Donbas into the Russian economic space, which gives rise to new opportunities for the implementation of joint projects in the industrial sphere, educational and scientific cooperation.

The combined online and offline format of the conference allowed more than seventy specialists and scientists from different cities and regions of the Russian Federation, including Moscow, Saint Petersburg, Novgorod, Rostov-on-Don and Belarus, Kazakhstan and others taking part in the event. In the unfolding scientific discussion the issues of the development of the economy of the Russian Federation in the context of global challenges of the development of scientific and technical cooperation with China and the BRICS countries, Global macroeconomic instability in the face of new geopolitical realities and many others were discussed.

The proceedings of the conference are planned to be published. They will be placed in the database of the Russian Scientific Citation Index (RSCI).

The II Congress of Young Scientists, which took place in «Sirius» (Sochi) on December 1-3, is the main event of the first year within the Decade of Science and Technology 2022-2031 in Russia. Internship of teachers and students of the Automobile and Road Institute of Donetsk National Technical University within the framework of development of the Inter-University Student Engineering and Technology Corporation (MSITC) and cooperation of 24 universities of the Russian Federation on project education took place in MSTU named after N.E. Bauman on November 21- December 2.

The Gorlovka group included the Dean of the Road-Transport Faculty the Associate Professor V.V. Bykov, the Professor Assistants A.I. Petrov, S.E. Volkov, the students Dmitry Kalugin, Sofia Egorova, Nikita Korolyov, and Nikita Vostrikov.

The working meeting with the Rector M.V. Gorin was also held, during which directions for further cooperation between the two universities were developed.

The practical part of the internship was held at the production base of MSITC in Orekhovo-Zuyevsky City District. Representatives of ADI DONNTU were familiarized with the design of prototypes of the youth roadster «Crimea», the kits of which and documentation, as well as technological features are provided to project participants.

Automobile and Road Institute DONNTU has already received the load-bearing system roadster «Crimea» and is actively engaged in the construction of its own version of a youth sports car. Each university-participant makes its own changes in the design of roadster «Crimea» and makes it unique. ADI DONNTU plans to use an unconventional engine of its own design with a modular cylinder shut-off.

As part of the technological breaks, the participants got acquainted with the joint project of the Design Bureau of the MSTU youth and Military Industrial Company (WPC) - the prototype of the car «Strela», which was

presented at all-Russian technological forums many times and has aroused great interest of customers.

MSTU staff acquainted teachers and students with the technology of manufacturing from composites of external body panels of the youth roadster, told about the intricacies and nuances of the choice of appropriate technology at a given standard. The students prepared matrices, restored surfaces and applied anti-adhesive material, conducted a number of other technological operations.

The busy schedule of practical classes included lectures. The project manager is the Director of the Scientific and Educational Center «Formula-Student» of MSTU Professor D.O. Onishchenko who delivered an open lecture on «Joint Development of Transport and Stationary Energy». Teachers of the Faculty of Linguistics held an intensive course on «Features of the Use of Technical English for Communication with Specialists and Translation of Specialized Texts», and the Department of Jurisprudence, intellectual property and forensics told the students what security in the digital world is.

Excursions to machine-building enterprises in Orekhovo-Zuyevo City District were organized for the guest. The Director for Development K.O. Kutepov and the Deputy Chief Designer I.O. Horshov, a graduate of the Moscow State University showed them the «LiAZ» plant, a manufacturer of a wide range of buses and coaches.

At the machine-building plant «Tonar», which develops and produces dump trucks and semi-trailers, the technological and production chains of the enterprise were demonstrated to the guests.

Cooperation of ADI DONNTU with MSTU named after N.E. Bauman and Interuniversity Youth Engineering Technological Corporation will provide transfer of knowledge and educational technologies between two universities of the Russian Federation and will provide an opportunity to prepare our Gorlovsky students to work with digital duplicates of designed objects within the framework of the digital development program for Russian economy. Participation in such a structure is an excellent platform for the training of personnel for the motor transport complex of our country, as well as for other branches of it. ADI DONNTU has access to a single digital knowledge base to share experiences with students of other universities, which is an excellent stimulant to improve the practical skills of students and graduate students and upgrade the qualifications of graduates.

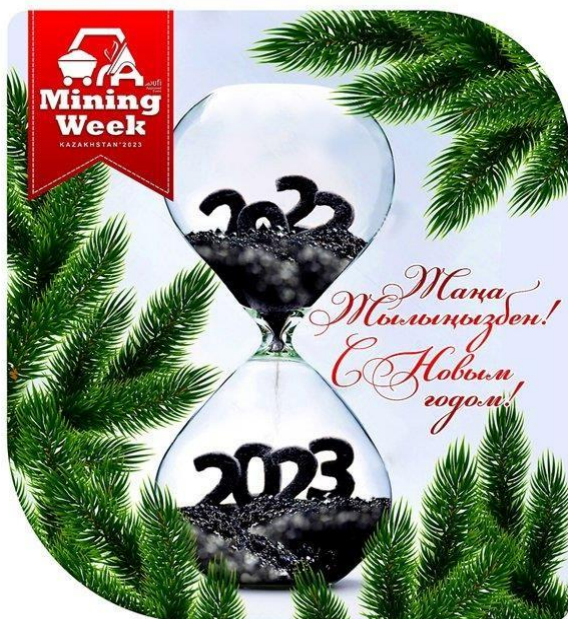
## **V Republican (with International Participation) Contest of Entrepreneurial Ideas “Agrarian Business and Youth Initiative”**
